DAY 1:

Lake Manyara National Park- Monday, June 8, 2026

After breakfast, you will depart from your lodge and head for a full-day game drive in Lake Manyara National Park. Famous for its legendary tree-climbing lions, the park offers a spectacular introduction to Tanzania's wildlife. It is also a paradise for bird lovers, with over 400 recorded bird species, including large flocks of flamingos along the lake shore. The park covers approximately 325 km², of which about 230 km² is lake surface, and features five distinct vegetation zones ranging from groundwater forest to open grasslands. You will enjoy a scenic game drive with a picnic lunch inside the park. Later in the afternoon, you will proceed to Karatu / Manyara for dinner and overnight.

Site visits: Lake Manyara Area

Approximate driving time: 2 hours to the park

Commonly seen animals: : Flamingo, elephant, giraffe, hippo, buffalo, zebra, wildebeest, lion, jackal, vulture, warthog, impala, ostrich, waterbuck.

Meals: Breakfast & Lunch

Overnight: TBA

DAY 2:

Game drive at Serengeti - Tuesday, June 9, 2026

After an early breakfast, you will depart from Karatu and drive to Serengeti National Park. Serengeti is home to one of nature's greatest spectacles — the Great Migration. Each year, millions of wildebeest, zebras, and antelopes cross the vast plains in search of fresh grazing and water. The park is also renowned for the iconic Big Five: lion, elephant, leopard, buffalo, and rhino. Predators such as lions, leopards, and hyenas roam freely across the plains, making every game drive an unforgettable adventure. Upon arrival, you will enjoy an afternoon game drive en route to your camp.

Site visits: Serengeti National Park

Approximate driving time: 4-5 hours to destinations

Commonly seen animals: Elephant, buffalo, giraffe, zebra, gazelle, lion, cheetah, leopard, impala, dik-dik, wildebeest.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Overnight: TBA

DAY 3:

Hot Air Balloon Safari - Serengeti National Park - Wednesday, June 10, 2026

Early in the morning, you will depart from your lodge for a magical hot air balloon safari organized by Miracle Experience. As the sun rises over the Serengeti plains, you will float silently above the wildlife, enjoying breathtaking panoramic views and a unique bird's-eye perspective of the ecosystem. After landing, you will be treated to a luxurious bush breakfast prepared by professional chefs in the heart of the wilderness.



Later, you will continue with a game drive in the park, followed by lunch and further wildlife viewing before returning to your accommodation for dinner and overnight

Approximate driving time: Full-day game drive

Expected game drive: Morning.

DAY 4:

Full Game Drive - Serengeti National Park - Thursday, June 11, 2026

After breakfast, enjoy another full day exploring the endless plains of Serengeti. Depending on the season, your guide will track wildlife movements to maximize your chances of witnessing predator action or migration herds. The open savannah offers excellent wildlife viewing and photography opportunities.

Site visits: Serengeti National Park

Approximate driving time: Full-day game drive

Expected game drive: Morning.

Commonly seen animals: Elephant, buffalo, giraffe, zebra, gazelle, lion, cheetah, leopard, impala, dik-dik, wildebeest

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Overnight: TBA

DAY 5:

Game Drive at Ngorongoro Conservation Area - Thursday, June 12, 2026

After breakfast, you will depart for a full-day crater tour in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Often referred to as the “Cradle of Mankind,” Ngorongoro is the world’s largest intact and unfilled volcanic caldera and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will descend 600 meters to the crater floor, home to an extraordinary concentration of wildlife. This natural sanctuary offers excellent chances of spotting the endangered black rhino along with lion, buffalo, zebra, and many other species. Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the crater before continuing your afternoon game drive. Later, you will proceed to your lodge in Karatu / Ngorongoro for dinner and overnight.

Site visits: Ngorongoro Crater

Approximate driving time: 3-6 hours drive

Commonly seen animals: Elephant, black rhino, buffalo, zebra, lion, hyena, warthog, kudu, mongoose, dik-dik

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Overnight: TBA

DAY 6:

Karatu / Ngorongoro - Arusha - Friday, June 13, 2025

After breakfast, you will drive to Arusha City for drop-off. Airport transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport can be arranged upon request.

Approximate driving time: 2 hours drive
